The objective of the project is to strengthen the capacity of the House of Teachers "Spiru Haret" Iasi to introduce and promote the latest instruments of the Council of Europe in terms of democratic school culture and to support them in implementing innovative practices in the process.

Improve the skills of Methodist teachers and trainers of CCD Iasi through participation of Methodist teachers and trainers of CCD Iasi in the 2 learning mobility; 3. Elaboration of 4 approved courses, and of an accredited course; 4. Creating an intervention methodology in the teaching-learning-assessment process, containing methods, facilitation techniques and tools useful for carrying out interdisciplinary educational projects that place the student at the center of the educational act and that promote democratic school culture and human rights; 5. Elaborate outlines and creating materials for 4 approved courses on social inclusion, participatory democracy, experiential learning, effective communication, encouraging tolerance and eliminating the phenomenon of bullying and promoting them in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes;-disseminating and promoting the courses proposed in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes; 6. Supporting 2 Workshops for teachers: „ Use of interactive methods in interdisciplinary projects on the topic„School democracy and civic responsibilities „, and „ Everybody’s different - a new way of thinking about human difference starting with the idea that difference is a

common aspect of human development „.

7. Training of 200 teachers and school principals who will participate in the approved training courses and in the accredited course.

Target group

The target group directly targets 10 methodist teachers and trainers of CCD Iasi to be trained in the two training courses, focusing to: respect for the values of democracy; promoting intercultural dialogue; avoiding / preventing discrimination of any kind in the school institution and in the community; respect for human rights in student-student, student-parent-teacher relations; celebrating diversity in the classroom and in school, but also in the school community; promoting human dignity, self-confidence and trust in others; integration in formal and non-formal educational activities of the principle of respecting equal opportunities for all students; creating an inclusive learning environment based on integration, trust and collaboration. and 250 teachers belonging.

These 250 teachers from Iasi County will be trained and become skilled in applying and developing educational methods and strategies on social inclusion of students and young people. Also, as a follow-up and sustainability, a total number of 250 teachers (10 groups) will be trained by attending the CCD course accredited by MEN.

Activities

The project calendar includes the following activities:

- November 2021 - Evaluation of training course in Norway and dissemination activities; dissemination of the training course in Norway through press releases, articles, workshops and PPT presentations to be sent via the yahoo rdp Iasi group and published on the CCD web page and on the Facebook and eTwinning pages of the project;

encouraging tolerance and eliminating the phenomenon of bullying and promoting them in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes;-disseminating and promoting the courses proposed in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes;

- May 2022 – July 2022 -Training course for Teachers -Elaborating outlines and creating materials for 4 approved courses on social inclusion, participatory democracy, experiential learning, effective communication, stress management, encouraging tolerance and eliminating the phenomenon of bullying and promoting them in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes;-disseminating and promoting the courses proposed in the offer of CCD Iasi training programmes

-June 2022 – August 2022- Start the accredited training course for teachers (piloting)

- October 2022 – Piloting accredited training course for teachers

- Follow-up meeting in Romania November 2022-December 2022 (Presentation of results and challenges experienced; Evaluation of the training activity (including post-training survey); Future plans a& network building

-December 2022-The final evaluation of the project.

Results

The expected project outcomes achieved during and after the project will be:The tangible results of the project are represented by all the course materials made by the participants both during the training courses, study visits but also during the workshops, which will contribute to updating the training offer of CCD Iasi 4 approved courses, one course accredited, a guide of good practices, as an open educational resource, 200 trained teachers, 100 lesson plans / practical activities applied by teachers in the classroom, certificates of participation, individual reports, dissemination materials.

For Casa Corpului Didactic „ Spiru Haret,, Iasi, the expected project outcomes are:At institutional level, the “Democracy starts with you!”project aims to develop the training offer through new courses and by updating existing courses with new methods, contents and approaches, in accordance with the needs identified by CCD Iasi.
